Transit supervisors are first responders to accidents, fire, disputes, and other situations that have an impact on transit service. They're the ones who help get transit services back in gear through on-scene emergency management.

But the Coast Mountain Bus Company doesn't care. They've already cut eight front-line supervisor positions from the system, and now they're cutting nine maintenance supervisor positions—with talk of more cuts to come.

Coast Mountain has been directed by Translink to cut costs. But imposing widespread service delays and gaps in emergency response is no way to do it.
