Transit supervisors are first responders to accidents, fire, disputes, and other situations that have an impact on transit service. They're the ones who help get transit services back in gear through on-scene emergency management. Metro Vancouver's transit supervisors have been providing this service for more than 50 years.

But Translink, in a bid to trim budgets, has decided that it's an "acceptable risk" for the Coast Mountain Bus Company to cut eight front-line supervisor positions and nine maintenance supervisor positions from the system.
